On the eve of the official visit of President of Kyrgyzstan Almazbek Atambayev to India **IA "24.kg"** recalls the events that preceded it.

In 2015 in the framework of a week-long tour in Central Asian countries there was a visit of Prime Minister of India Mr. Narendra Modi in Kyrgyzstan. One of the main topics of the talks with colleagues in the region was cooperation on countering terrorism and extremism and other fields, drawing attention to the growing influence of the "Islamic state".



In addition, the talks of Mr. Modi and Almazbek Atambayev were concluded with the signing of two agreements - on cooperation in the military sphere and in the sphere of culture, art, youth, sport and media.

- ***The sides expressed satisfaction with the second round of joint exercises "Khanjar 2015" special forces, held in Kyrgyzstan in March 2015 and which is a continuation of the exercise of 2011 in India. It was decided to conduct them annually.***

Also, Narendra Modi has proposed Kyrgyzstan to cooperate in developing a strategy for the development of trade and economic cooperation.

- ***Parties welcomed the launch of direct flights between Bishkek and New Delhi and agreed to promote transport links to promote trade and economic cooperation and tourism.***

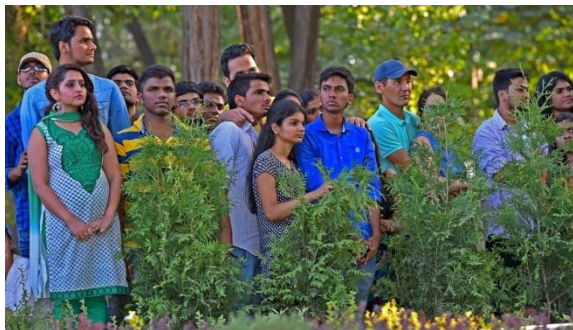


Taking into account that in countries, more than 60 percent of the population employed in the agricultural sector, the parties confirmed the necessity of cooperation in this area. The Indian side offered to share experience in the processing of agricultural products, the use of

greenhouse technologies, water conservation and use in agricultural research to increase productivity in the production of agricultural products.

During the visit of Prime Minister of India there was an opening of the monument of one of the leaders of the national liberation movement of India Mahatma Gandhi in the Park at the intersection of Molodaya Gvardiya and Jibek-Jolu.

Kyrgyzstan is a popular destination among Indian students for medical education. More than a thousand Kyrgyz civil servants were trained in the framework of the Indian technical cooperation programme (ITEC).



The quota of ITEC programme was increased from 85 to 100 for Kyrgyz citizens. Countries agreed to work on expanding of the Kyrgyz-Indian Information Centre at KSUCTA and to consider the possibility of opening similar centers in other major cities of Kyrgyzstan on the basis of Indian grants.

- ***The parties expressed satisfaction with development of cooperation in the sphere of health care, including regular visits by Indian doctors from tertiary hospitals of India to Kyrgyzstan.***

Almazbek Atambayev expressed gratitude to the Indian side for the provision of medical equipment for military field hospital of the Ministry of Defense of the Kyrgyz Republic and supported the proposals of India on the issue of UN reform.

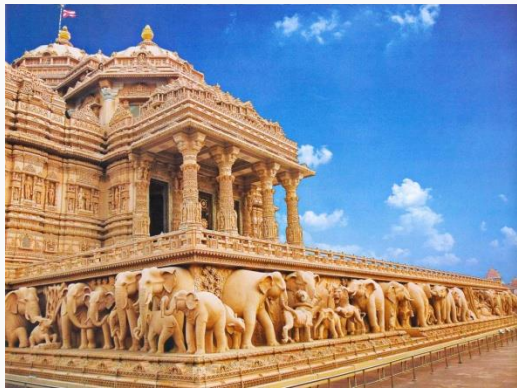


On the eve of the visit of the President of the Kyrgyz Republic in India, the deputies of the Jogorku Kenesh ratified the Memorandum on joining of India and Pakistan to the Shanghai cooperation organization.

They signed the following documents:

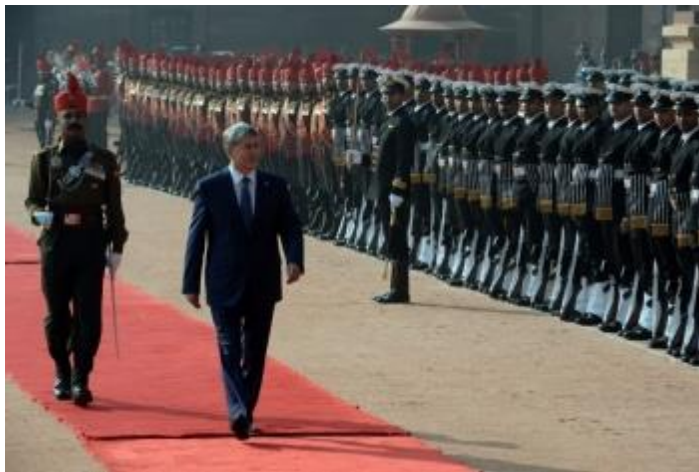
1. Joint statement by heads of delegation.

Gifts, meetings, shots. Why Atambayev traveled to India?

19 December 2016 President of the Kyrgyz Republic Almazbek Atambayev left for an official visit to India.



Yesterday, December 20, Atambayev met with President Pranab Mukherjee and Prime Minister of India, Narendra Modi. The official welcoming ceremony was held at the presidential palace, "Rashtrapati Bhavan". At the entrance of the Kyrgyz presidential motorcade through the main gate of the presidential palace, accompanied by equestrian escort, presidential guard made a salute of 21 guns.



We will learn the purpose for which the official visit of the head of state to a friendly country took place.

What kind of important documents were signed?

Within the framework of the state visit of the ceremony of exchange of signed bilateral documents.

So, the following documents were signed:

Memorandum between the Government of Kyrgyzstan and the Government of India on cooperation in tourism;

- Memorandum on cooperation in youth policy between the State Agency for Youth, Sports and Physical Education of Kyrgyzstan and the Ministry of Youth and Sports of India;

- Agreement on cooperation in agriculture, food processing and reclamation of the Kyrgyz Republic and the Ministry of Agriculture and the welfare of farmers of India;

- Memorandum of Understanding between the Kyrgyz military lyceum named after Major General Dayir Asanov and National Cadet Corps of India;

- Memorandum of Understanding between the Diplomatic Academy of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Institute of Foreign Relations of the Republic of India;

- Memorandum of Understanding between the Kyrgyz Public National TV/Radio Corporation (KTRK) and Prasar Bharati on cooperation in the field of broadcasting and exchange of audiovisual products.



What exactly?

- During the meeting, the Indian side said about the decision to provide Kyrgyzstan with medical equipment for the treatment of cancer Bhabhatron worth \$ 1.5-2 million.
- The parties agreed on the establishment of the Kyrgyz-Indian fund to support entrepreneurs.

Who else met Atambayev?

Within the framework of the state visit of Atambayev December 20 met with Vice President of India Hamid Ansari.

During the meeting, Vice President of India Hamid Ansari expressed the opinion that taking into account the historical ties between the two peoples, as well as a solid base for increased trade and economic relations between Kyrgyzstan and India, President Almazbek Atambayev's visit will give a powerful impetus to the development of the Kyrgyz-Indian ties in all areas.

President Almazbek Atambayev also stressed the need to strengthen cooperation on a wide range of issues, especially noting the importance of increasing trade and economic cooperation.

President Almazbek Atambayev also met with Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

President of Kyrgyzstan Almazbek Atambayev, yesterday, December 20, in the framework of the state visit to the Republic of India, met with the Prime Minister of India, Narendra Modi.



During the meeting the parties noted that Kyrgyzstan and India share traditional ties of friendship, long-standing cultural and historical ties, both countries are also democracies. These factors provide a solid foundation for the development and strengthening of bilateral cooperation.

Parties reached agreement on the strengthening of political dialogue and cooperation within the UN and the SCO, to intensify trade and economic cooperation, increase trade, as well as establishment of practical cooperation in the areas of agriculture, health, IT technologies, security, defence and mining.

Press Statements

President Almazbek Atambayev has presented Prime Minister Narendra Modi trilogy "Manas Semetei-Seytek" in Hindi, which was published on December 20 this year and timed to coincide with this visit.

Narendra Modi, in turn, presented the book in the Kyrgyz language "India akyndarynyn poemalary jana yrlary" - "Omur boektoru", which was also released for the visit.

Almazbek Atambayev and Prime Minister of India, Narendra Modi on the conclusion of the negotiations made press statements.

The Prime Minister noted that with special warmth remembers his official visit to Kyrgyzstan in July 2015.

"Our peoples are connected centuries-old historical ties One of the main aspirations of our common is the construction of a democratic society merit Atambayev also lies in the fact that he is making every effort to build a solid foundation for democracy." - Said the Prime Minister of India.

Narendra Modi also said that during the talks with the President held a broad discussion on a range of issues of mutual interest.

"We discussed the possibility of participation of our countries in the fight against terrorism, extremism and radicalism. We came to an agreement about what should be a coordinated effort to ensure security in the region. Kyrgyzstan is considered India as a valuable partner in promoting stability in Central Asia" - said Narendra Modi.

President Almazbek Atambayev, in turn, thanked the Prime Minister of India for the invitation to visit India .

"We, Kyrgyzstan and India share fundamental values such as human rights, freedom of speech, democracy and the rule of law we would like to see our relationship is now more active in the economic field.", - Said the head of state.

"We need to dramatically increase the volume of trade, existing indicators can't fail to satisfy us, We also discussed the logistics.", - Said the head of the state.
